New Gedney Board Members: I am pleased to announce that we elected two new members to the Gedney Association Board of Directors, Albert Dold of Little John Place to a full three year term and Robert Manger of Sherman Avenue to a one year term. We also reelected Guy D'Antona of Ridgeway, Midge Sanchez of Easton Avenue and Terence Guerriere of Dupont Avenue (that's me) to new three year terms. FASNY: The letter would not be complete without an update on the French American School's plans for the former Ridgeway Country Club property. As stated in our last email, the process continues. FASNY is now in the process of answering all of the substantive questions and comments made by the public and city departments, boards and commissions. There is no set timeframe for this response. Once the information is received by the City, a Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) will be produced. It is on this FEIS that the Common Council will vote. Although it is difficult to predict, it will reasonable to assume that the vote would likely take place in the spring.

OSReD Rezoning: The Council will likely soon act on the proposed Open Space/Recreation District (OSReD). As you may recall from previous emails, the OSReD proposal would change the zoning for certain large tracts of land including Maplemoor Golf Course, the former Ridgeway County Club property (FASNY) and Westchester Hills Golf Club. The environmental review process (SEQR) is close to completion and a decision is likely to be made in the coming months.
